



**Stay Safe** Public safety officials may alert the entire community, or specific neighborhoods using the CodeRED system. CodeRED Weather Warning will alert all subscribed residents within the direct path of severe weather.

**Alert Types** CodeRED messages may include missing person alerts, boil water advisories and evacuations, or routine announcements that do not require immediate action, depending on the discretion of the local alerting authority. CodeRED Weather Warning notifications are automatically sent out moments after a severe thunderstorm, tornado or flash flood warning has been issued by the National Weather Service. Only residents in the immediate area of impact will be alerted.

**Caller ID** You will recognize the following types of CodeRED calls by the numbers below. Make sure to save these numbers in your phone's contacts. If you would like to hear the last message delivered to your phone, simply call the number back.
