NOTICE OF ELECTION

The City of St. Marys, Georgia will hold a General Election on November 8, 2016 to elect a Mayor and three (3) Council Members representing Post #4, #5, and #6. In accord with H.B. 105, passed 2011, all terms shall be for a period of four (4) years. Each position shall hold office from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2020. **All candidates will run at large and be elected by simple majority vote.**

Prospective candidates desiring to be a candidate for Mayor or Council shall qualify in person at the City Clerk's office in City Hall, 418 Osborne Street, St. Marys, Georgia between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Qualifying will begin on Monday, August 15, 2016 and end on Friday, August 19, 2016 at 4:30 p.m.

The qualifying fee for the Mayor is \$342.00 and Council is \$270.00, payable to the City of St. Marys at the time of qualifying.

Early Advance Voting shall begin on Monday, October 17, 2016 through November 4, 2016 at the Camden County Board of Registrar's office in the Historic Courthouse, 200 East 4th Street; Woodbine, Georgia between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. local time.

The deadline for Voter Registration for the General Election shall be at the close of business on October 11, 2016.

The General Election shall be conducted at Salvation Army (SOUTHERN VOTING PRECINCT), 1915 Osborne Street; the Salvation Army (NORTHERN VOTING PRECINCT), 1915 Osborne Street; St. Marys Middle School (WESTERN VOTING PRECINCT), 205 Martha Drive; Mary Lee Clark Elementary School, 318 Mickler Drive; and Mush Bluff Fire Station, 3557 Charlie Smith Sr. Highway, St. Marys, Georgia between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. local eastern time on Election Day.
