INVITATION TO BID

Legal Notice

1. Sealed proposals for **Douglas Drive Drainage Improvements**, owned by the City of St. Marys, Georgia will be received by the City of St. Marys, Georgia at St. Marys City Hall until Tuesday, August 7, 2018 at 2:00 P.M. at which time they will be publicly opened. The bid opening will be held in the City Council Chambers of St. Marys City Hall, located at 418 Osborne Street, St. Marys, Georgia.
2. The project consists of the following generally described work:

Provide all labor, materials, equipment, incidentals and appurtenances to construct drainage improvements on Douglas Drive. Construction includes removal and replacement of the existing base and asphalt pavement and removal of drainage structures and pipes to accommodate installation of proposed Reinforced Concrete Pipes and Four (4) 6' x 4' Concrete Box Culverts totaling 320 LF and associated wing walls. Construction includes demolition, grading and drainage, base and paving, water and sewer utilities relocation and sidewalk replacement.
3. Plans and Specifications are open to inspection at the offices of Thomas & Hutton, 1503 Newcastle Street, Suite A, Brunswick, Georgia 31520 beginning Thursday, July 5, 2018 at 9 AM. Plans and specifications can be obtained by hard copy or by email request for digital files to Montgomery.r@thomasandhutton.com. Upon receipt of payment to Thomas & Hutton, by check, in the amount of \$ 150.00, plans will be released as appropriate. The payment is non-refundable.
4. Bids shall be accompanied by a bid bond or certified cashier's check in an amount not less than 10% of the base bid. All bonds shall be by a surety company licensed in Georgia with an "A" minimum rating of performance and a financial strength of at least five times the contract price as listed in the most current publication of "Best's Key Rating Guide Property Liability." Bids shall also be accompanied by completed Bidder's Qualifications forms as provided in the Contract Documents. Performance and Payment Bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price shall be required of the successful bidder if contract is awarded. Each Bond shall be accompanied by a "Power of Attorney" authorizing the attorney-in-fact to bind the surety and certified to include the date of the bond.
5. Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, including without limitation, the rights to reject any or all nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced or conditional Bids and to reject the Bid of any Bidder if Owner believes it would not be in the best interest of the Project to make an award to Bidder, whether because the Bid is not responsive or the Bidder is unqualified or of doubtful financial ability or fails to meet any other pertinent standard or criteria established by the Owner.
6. A Non-Mandatory Pre-Bid conference will be held on Tuesday, July 31, 2018 at 2 P.M. at St. Marys City Hall in the City Council Chambers.
