

NOTICE OF HOME RULE AMENDMENT TO THE ST. MARYS CITY CHARTER

Notice is hereby given that the St. Marys City Council is considering an amendment to Section 6-102 (b) of the St. Marys City Charter, Ga. Laws 1981, page 4763, as amended. The second reading of the Charter Amendment shall be on July 16, 2018. The St. Marys City Council may vote on the amendment at that time.

The amendment is for the purpose of providing for one year terms for the chief judge of the municipal court instead of the four year terms as now provided in Section 6-102(b) of the St. Marys City Charter, Ga. Laws 1981, page 4763, as amended.

A copy of the proposed amendment is on file and available for public inspection in the Office of the Clerk of the City of St. Marys and in the Office of the Clerk of the Camden County Superior Court. The Clerk of the City of St. Marys shall furnish anyone, upon written request, a copy of the proposed amendment.
