Work to be done:

The work to be done under this Contract shall include all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to provide for the successful reconstruction of the Renovations to Orange Hall as outlined in the Bid Documents and project specifications.

All other required Contract Documents must be fully completed and executed by the Contractor and his/her Surety, and submitted to the Owner on or before the issuance of Notice to Proceed.
