

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Proposals will be received for evaluation by the owner, City of St Marys, Mr. Steven Crowell, City Manager, 418 Osborne Road, St Marys, GA 31558, until 2:00 p.m. on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2014, to Crack Seal and Remark Runway 13-31, Taxiway and Apron at St Marys Airport in Camden County, Georgia.

The Contractor's Proposal will include the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, and all things necessary pursuant to Drawings, Specifications and Conditions, etc., to Crack Seal and Remark Runway 13-31, Taxiway and Apron St Marys Airport, RAC 14001.20 (the "Project").

The Project generally includes crack sealing the entire parallel taxiway, the apron and Runway 13-31 from displaced threshold to displaced threshold, as well as the marking and striping of Runway 13-31, the taxiway and the apron. Contract Documents are open to the public at 418 Osborne Road in the City of St Marys and at the office of Robert and Company, Architects-Engineers-Planners. Plans can be purchased for one-hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) for hard copy documents or thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for electronic documents on CD.

No Proposal will be considered unless accompanied by a certified check or acceptable Bid Bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the bid and made payable to the City of St Marys.

All bids must be made out on the separate proposal form furnished with the Contract Documents in accordance with the instructions in the Instructions to Bidders. No interlineations, additions or deletions shall be made in the Proposal form by the bidder.

Successful Bidder shall be required to furnish a Contract Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each equal to 100% of the Contract Price, with the terms and surety to be approved by the Owner; and furnish satisfactory proof of carriage of the insurance required.

The Owner reserves the right, with or without notice or cause to accept any bid regardless of the amount thereof; to reject any bid, any number of bids or all bids; to negotiate with any bidder for a reduction or alteration in its bid; to waive or insist upon formal requirements; to reject all bids and to call for additional bids upon the same or different invitation to bid, Plans and Specifications; to be the sole judge, in its discretion, of all questions as to whether or not a bid complies with the Invitation to Bid, the Plans or the Specifications, and as to the qualifications of a bidder to perform the Contract.

Bidders shall inform themselves concerning Georgia laws and comply with same. Bidders shall inform themselves of and comply with the following regulations:

- Buy American Preferences (Title 49, United States Code, Chapter 501)
- Foreign Trade Restriction (DOT Regulation 49 CFR Part 30)
- Davis Bacon Act (DOL Regulation 29 CFR Part 5)
- Affirmative Action to Ensure Equal Employment Opportunity (Executive Order 11246 and DOL Regulations 41 CFR Part 60)
- Government Wide Debarment and Suspension and Government Requirements for Drug-Free Workplace (DOT Regulation 49 CFR Part 29)

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

The successful bidder shall commence work with adequate force and equipment on a date to be specified in a written order of the Engineer and shall complete the work within 45 consecutive calendar days.
