Bids received after the above date and time or in any location other than the office stated above will be rejected. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days. A mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at The City of St. Marys Council Chambers at 418 Osborne Street, St. Marys, GA 31558, on Monday, September 14, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. All proposers must make an on-site inspection of the location where the work will be performed to become completely familiar with the existing conditions.
