



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS  
PAVEMENT CONDITION SURVEY AND EVALUATION SERVICES  
JANUARY 13, 2015 – 2:00 PM

The City of St. Marys, GA will be receiving sealed proposals from a qualified consultant to collect pavement condition survey and evaluation services of city streets which consist of approximately 105 centerline miles. Proposals shall be received up to and until 2:00 PM, EST, January 13, 2015, by the Purchasing Department located at 418 Osborne Street, St. Marys, GA 31558. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals received, and the right to waive any informality not deemed in the best interest of the City.

Perform an inventory and pavement condition rating survey and evaluation for the City of St. Marys. The streets to be surveyed are public streets and roadways owned and maintained by the City of St. Marys.

All proposals must contain the following information:

1. Cover Letter and Company Profile
2. Overall Experience
3. Related Experience
4. Key Personnel Experience/Staff Qualifications with Resumes.
6. Project Responsiveness/Ability to meet schedules and deadlines.
7. Project Understanding and Approach.
8. Proposed Project Schedule.
9. Cost Proposal.

The above criteria shall be the basis of scoring the proposals received. Each item (1-9 above) will be scored independently by a review committee of City staff on a scale of 1 (low) – 10 (high) and totaled for each firm. An average for each firm will be determined based on the scores of the review committee members. Based on the number of proposals received, a short list of the top scoring firms **may** be called in for oral presentations to the review committee. The review committee will make a recommendation to the City Council based on the original proposal package and the oral presentations, if any.

All Respondents must submit five (5) proposal packages to the City for Review. Each package shall contain the full name and address of each person/company submitting the package. It shall also contain the words “Request for Proposals – St. Marys Road Gateway Enhancement Project” on the outside of the sealed submittal envelope. A copy of the Respondents standard Contract/Service Agreement must be included with each proposal submitted. All Respondents should be aware that oral presentations **may** be required.

The City of St. Marys will not be liable for any costs incurred by Respondents in the preparation of Proposal packages nor in costs associated with any element of the selection and contract negotiation process. Any Responders that contact elected officials or staff directly or indirectly for the purpose of influencing the selection process prior to a contract award shall be immediately disqualified and removed from consideration.
