INVITATION FOR BID ST. MARYS FY 2013 LMIG

THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, GA PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT solicits bids for the St. Marys FY 2013 LMIG Project. Bids will be received in the office of Amy Peeples, St. Marys City Hall, Finance Department, 418 Osborne Street, St. Marys, Georgia 31558, until 2:00 p.m., EST., on October 16, 2014 and shall be publicly opened on the same date in the St. Marys City Hall, 418 Osborne Street, St. Marys, Georgia 31558. Bids received after the above date and time or in any location other than the office stated above will be rejected. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

One (1) original and two (2) copies of the COMPLETE bid package must be submitted in a SEALED envelope/package. The name of the company or firm submitting a bid must also be clearly marked on the outside of the bid package. The bid package must be clearly labeled with the following information:

Work to be done:

The Work shall consist of a new right turn, curb & gutter, sidewalk and signal modification on St Marys Road and sewer improvements on L & Grace Streets as detailed in the plans and specifications.

The Work shall also include all traffic control and cleaning associated with the construction of the project. The Contractor shall provide the necessary labor, construction equipment, fuel, materials, striping, and etc. required for the successful completion of the project. All Work shall conform to the Project Plans, Specifications, current edition of the Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications Construction of Transportation Systems, and all applicable local, state and federal codes and regulations. In the case of a conflict, Project Specifications shall take precedence. Contract time shall be **120** consecutive calendar days from the date of the Notice to Proceed.

Bonds: Contractor to submit with the sealed bid a Bid Bond as noted in the Bid Bond Requirements. No bid will be considered without following this procedure. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, on or before the issuance of Notice to Proceed, each in the amount of 100% of the Contract Amount. All other required Contract Documents must be fully completed and executed by the Contractor and his/her Surety, and submitted to the Owner on or before the issuance of Notice to Proceed.

The City of St. Marys will select the bid that, in its sole discretion is the most responsive and responsible to the City. The City is not liable for any cost incurred by vendors in the preparation of this bid.

Unauthorized contact regarding this invitation to bid with staff or elected officials may result in disqualification. Any oral communications will be considered unofficial and non-binding on the City of St. Marys. Vendors should rely only on written statements.
