

**INVITATION TO BID
CITY OF ST. MARYS
SR HIGHWAY 40 PAVEMENT REPAIRS**

THE City of St. Marys Public Works Department is soliciting bids for the **SR Highway 40 – Pavement Repairs**. Bids will be received in the office of the Amy Peeples, Finance Department, St. Marys City Hall, 418 Osborne Street, St. Marys, Georgia 31558, until 2:00, EST on January 3, 2013 and shall be publicly opened on the same date in the St. Marys City Hall, 418 Osborne Street, St. Marys, Georgia 31558. Bids received after the above time or in any other location other than the Purchasing Office will not be accepted. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope with the bid name clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. The name of the company or firm submitting a bid should also be clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. **TWO (2) ORIGINAL COPIES MUST BE SUBMITTED.**

Work to be done:

The work to be done under this Contract shall include all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to provide for the successful completion of the project as outlined in the project specifications. This project consists of three separate pavement patches located on SR Highway 40, St. Marys Road, and Shadowlawn Drive. Total repairs under this project consists of 290 square feet of pavement patch repair; 22 linear feet of GDOT curb and gutter, replace one driveway curb cut, and replacement of 53 linear feet of 4 foot wide sidewalk. Also, included in this project are all demolition, compaction, traffic control, and debris removal.

Contractor must conform to all state, local, and federal regulations, including safety. Contractor must submit copies of all licenses, insurance, and must inspect the site prior to bidding project. Once project is started, work must be uninterrupted. Work must be completed within thirty (30) days of Notice to Proceed. All work will be coordinated with the City Public Works Department.

Bonds: Contractor to submit with the sealed bid a Bid Bond as noted in the Bid Bond Requirements. No bid will be considered without following this procedure. All other required Contract Documents must be fully completed and executed by the Contractor and his/her Surety, and submitted to the Owner on or before the issuance of Notice to Proceed.
