

**INVITATION FOR BID**

Bids received after the above date and time or in any location other than the office stated above will be rejected. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

**One (1) original and two (2) copies of the COMPLETE bid package must be submitted in a SEALED envelope/package.** The name of the company or firm submitting a bid must also be clearly marked on the outside of the bid package.
