**Curbside Garbage Service Guidelines**

The following items will be picked up weekly on the designated pick up day for your area. These items must be set up at curbside prior to 6:00 A.M. for pick up.

**GARBAGE**

**WHITE GOODS (Fridays)**

**BULK ITEMS**

- You will be provided with a 90-gallon garbage container on wheels.
- Household garbage will be picked up once a week on the designated day for your area.
- Only Household garbage should be dispensed of in the container provided.
- Up to 2 additional standard 32 gallon size containers with handles may be purchased and used.
- The following items cannot be mixed with household garbage:

Scrap metal	Dead animals	Concrete	Ashes
Shingles	Tires	Oil	Bricks
Dirt	Gas tanks		

**Any other hazardous waste or items deemed unacceptable by E. P. D. or the City of St Marys cannot be mixed with household garbage.**

- Bulk items will be picked up from the curb of residence generating the bulk item. These items will be picked up with your household garbage. Bulky items are items such as mattresses, box springs, chairs, couches, tables, microwaves and televisions. Please call the Utility Department Office @ 912-510-4026 or 912-510-4027 to schedule pick-up.
- White Goods will be picked up at the curb of the residence generating the appliance. White goods are picked up by appointment. You must call the Curbside Collection Office to schedule the Friday pickup. White goods include refrigerators, freezers, stoves and air conditions.

***Yard waste cannot be mixed with household garbage.***

**There is no such thing as a COMMUNITY DUMP SITE. All solid waste items shall be placed at the curb of the residence generating the garbage, trash, yard waste, bulk items, etc.**

## Recycle Collection Program

**Recycling Collection:** Recycle material is picked up the same day as your garbage collection day.

#1 and #2 plastic bottles/jugs (rinse and remove all lids), aluminum/metal cans (rinse and remove lids), newspaper and inserts, brown paper bags, glass bottles and jars (rinse and remove all lids). Cardboard cut into 2x3. (Corrugated cardboard ONLY)

**Non-Recycle Items:** The following items will not be accepted: cereal boxes drink boxes, pizza boxes, plastic bags, butter tubs, juice and milk cartons, egg cartons, Styrofoam, pool and other chemical containers. Please do not place these items in your recycle bin.
