The request also includes additional gates on the south end and the northeast gate on Bartlett Street. Tax Parcel S40-01-003.
3. **RECONSTRUCTION:** The Oak Grove Cemetery Authority has submitted a Certificate of Appropriateness request to rebuild the exterior walls & roof of the existing 20'x20' work shed located within Oak Grove Cemetery, tax parcel S40-01-003.
4. **TREE REMOVAL:** The Oak Grove Cemetery Authority has submitted a Certificate of Appropriateness request to remove four trees located in Oak Grove Cemetery that appear to be in a hazardous condition and could possibly endanger public safety.
